DRIVEN TRAIL CLASS CHALLENGE A DAY OF DRIVING FUN AT WICKHAM PARK

This is a non-competitive event. You will follow a short course (at a walk or trot) with various fun “challenges” to test your skills. None of these challenges are designed to frighten your horse (no live animals, etc.) But with names like “Cones Two Ways”, “Doing Donuts”, “A Drop in the Bucket” and “Flag Waving” just to name a few ... you can see we have interesting things planned for you!

An “official observer” will watch each of your challenges—you’ll get a written comment sheet back, so you can try again later in the day to improve your skills. (*Drivers are limited to two “runs”, priority is given to let everyone drive the course once before the second drives take place.*)

Located just five miles off I-95 in Melbourne (Brevard County), Wickham Park is a county-owned park with a beautiful equestrian facility. It has lots of parking and easy access for large trailers, nice bathrooms, water and wash rack for horses, and there is “green space” beyond what we are using for the event, so you can drive around while waiting your turn at the course. (Please note: horses are allowed in the SW section of the park designated for equestrian activities only. And, although we’re not paying to have exclusive use of it, there is a large arena you may also practice in. We will be sharing this ring with individuals who could be using the park on this day.)

Event details: The course will be open from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m. Limited to 20 entries.

Registration fee: \$20 per entry, (additional \$15 fee if non-Whips members)

The club will provide water and snacks. Plan to bring your own lunch.
