Current business:

1. Sandy presented a rough outline of the club spending.

- The Florida Whps currently has about 200 members (give or take a few).
- With 200 members, the membership fee income is approximately \$8,375.
- So that makes:
 - Insurance consumes 45% of the income (1090.02 + \$2,581.61 = \$3,671.63)
 - Calendar consumes 25% of the income
 - Proposed awards will consume 20% of the income
 - 10% of income remains
